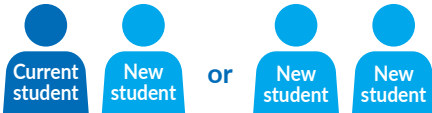

General English

Language Arts

The Language Arts course is designed to provide **holistic learning** to students using English and multiple areas of knowledge. English, mathematics, humanities, arts and the sciences are all taught through dynamic and engaging hands-on experiences involving both individual and group activities. In this way, students will enhance their **reasoning, problem solving and creative expression**.

Writer's Workshop

Courses are designed for students who wish to improve their **written communication skills** in a variety of writing formats. Students will be given a sample of a text type/format, and then receive **tailored instruction and feedback** on how to produce a high quality piece of writing of their own. Students will study and practise informative, analytical, descriptive, persuasive and creative writing skills.

Critical Thinking & Vocabulary

Students are exposed to critical global issues and contemporary developments through **graded texts, guided discussions, and intensive speaking activities**. **Key vocabulary** is introduced in context and strategically recycled and studied from a range of perspectives, to ensure students gain a deeper understanding of both the new words and the social and cultural issues explored in class.

Analysis & Commentary Writing

Students are exposed to a wide range of texts or literature (fiction and non-fiction) from around the world. Every lesson is followed by a guided written response. **Key vocabulary, linguistics and literary analysis** concepts are presented, discussed and practised. Students will develop general reading skills, language analysis and literary analysis skills applicable to IGCSE, IB and AP curricula.

General Chinese

Creative and interactive lessons with **special emphasis on vocabulary and common mistakes**. With tailored instruction and feedback from the teacher, students will have sufficient practice in **idioms, proverbs and famous sayings**, as well as acquire the skills necessary to complete varied assignments and succeed in reading and writing.

General Mathematics

Students will explore topics and concepts in mathematics through **interactive lessons and activities**. Completion of this programme will give students a solid foundation to various onward study paths, such as future studies in mathematics in the **I/GCSE and IB curriculum**. Students will be able to continue moving up the maths scholars programme in the coming academic year.

Science Lab

This camp is designed to introduce students to the **practical aspects of science**. Through demonstrations and hands-on experiments, we aim to **inspire and nourish students' interest in science**, as well as to prepare them for school studies and exams. 📖 Entrance Test Prep (Mathematics, English, Science)

This course is designed for all non-international curriculum students from Year 7 to 9 who are attempting for an international school in HK or overseas boarding school. The course content is separated into three modules, each lasting for one week. Students will be introduced to basic terminologies and concepts of some **Science and Mathematics topics** as well as **building up writing and reading skills for different English text types**. Students will be **familiar with international curriculum** and **develop essential techniques** required for entrance exams.

📖 English Junior Literature

This course trains students on fundamental literature analysis skills, which are prerequisite for studying international **English Language and Literature** curricula such as **I/GCSE** and **IB**. The course is designed to target students with little to no background in literature. After finishing this course, students are able to gain **text analysing skills** of the key elements of literature, ranging from genre, themes, plot structure, characterization to other common literary devices. This course thus enables students to better understand and appreciate popular junior literature.

📖 The New York Times Journalism Workshop

Students are exposed to current front-page news, feature articles and opinion columns from various sections of **The New York Times** through activities in reading and writing, from summarizing articles, to identifying features, to recognizing essential questions and answering the **5W1H**, from finding a newsworthy story and interviewing sources, to writing copy and copy editing, all culminating in reporting their news story.

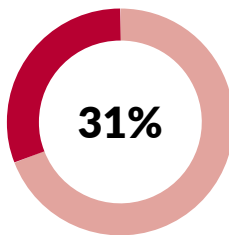

However, circular mail posted by the Government and related organisations, Legislative Councillors/District Councillors, election candidates, and charitable bodies eligible for tax relief under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance are exempted from this opt-out scheme.
